- v) **Certificate of Character signed by a member of the community e.g. Education Officer, Principal, Minister of Religion or Justice of the Peace.**
- vi) **Certified copies of educational certificates obtained and a progress report if attending University. Evidence of acceptance at UWI or Utech.**
- vii) **Copy of statement as outlined in Item 18.**

Incomplete applications will not be processed.

CONDITIONS

A. Candidates should be:-

- I. Jamaican citizens, domiciled in Jamaica during the last five (5) years;
- II. Not older than 25 years old on October 1st in the year of award;

B. Candidates will be required to enter into a bond to work in Jamaica for a period not exceeding five (5) years.

C. The Scholarship award is valid for the academic year immediately following the offer of the award and cannot be deferred for any reason.

The Ministry of Education invites application for the Elias A. Issa Scholarship to pursue an undergraduate degree course in the Faculty of Management Studies at the **University of the West Indies**, or the Faculty of Business Management (School of Business Administration) at the **University of Technology, Jamaica** beginning in August 2016.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants should:

- i) be below twenty-five (25) years of age on October 1, 2016;
- ii) be in possession of good passes at G.C.E. 'A' Level examinations or C.A.P.E.
- iii) have been accepted or currently studying at the University of the West Indies or the University of Technology.

VALUE

The Scholarship is intended to cover the cost of tuition fees for three (3) years and assist the recipient with books and maintenance costs.
