GENERAL TEACHERS' SCHOLARSHIP

- COURSE** : First Degree in Arts, Education, Economics or Accounts
- TENURE** : 2-4 years
- TENABLE** : At the University of the West Indies Mona Campus , University of Technology.
- VALUE** : Tuition Fee
- ELIGIBILITY** : Candidates should be:
- (a) Jamaican Nationals
 - (b) Desirous of pursuing a first degree in Arts, Education, Economics or Accounts.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- (a) All scholarships are tenable at the University of the West Indies, Mona or University of Technology.
- (b) All applicants should have been accepted at one of the above mentioned institution.
- (c) Successful candidates will be bonded to teach in a government owned educational institution for three (3) years.
- (d) The scholarship award is valid for the academic year immediately following the offer of the award and cannot be deferred for any reason.

ANNUAL JAMAICA SCHOLARSHIP

- COURSE** : Any First Degree
- TENURE** : Three (3) to five (5) years
- TENABLE** : At the University of the West Indies
- AGE LIMIT** : No older than 19 years on June 1 of the year of the qualifying exam (i.e. Cambridge 'A' Levels or C.A.P.E.)
- VALUE** : Covers tuition fees, Maintenance and Book Allowance
- ELIGIBILITY** : Candidates should: be persons who
- (1) are sitting the C.A.P.E. or the Cambridge 'A' Level examination in at least three subjects and General Paper in June.
 - (2) **i)** was born in Jamaica or born overseas to parents who are Jamaican citizens **or**
ii) have been naturalized as a Jamaican
 - (3) Having met the requirement of **(two) 2** above have resided in Jamaica for a period of at least five years immediately preceding the examination.
 - (4) In the case of the Jamaica Centenary Scholarship applicant (Male/Female) must submit a certificate showing that he/she has attended a public primary school (Infant school excluded) for at least three years. The 2016/2017 awardee will be a female.

(The seven (7) Jamaica Scholarships are awarded on a **yearly basis to candidates whose performance is the most outstanding in the G.C.E. 'A' Level Examinations or C.A.P.E.**)

CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- (a) Successful candidates will be bonded to work in Jamaica for a period not exceeding five (5) years.

- (b) The scholarship award is valid for the academic year immediately following the offer of the award and cannot be deferred for any reason.

ELIAS A. ISSA SCHOLARSHIP (*Established 1938*)
(Open to Male and Female in alternative years)

No. of Scholarships	:	1
COURSE	:	Management Studies (UWI) or Business Administration Degree (Utech), Hospitality and Tourism
TENURE	:	Three (3) years
TENABLE	:	At the University of the West Indies or the University of Technology
VALUE	:	The cost of tuition fees, books and maintenance allowance
AGE LIMIT	:	Be under 25 on the 1 st of October of the year of the award.
ELIGIBILITY	:	Candidate should:- (1) be Jamaican National(Born in Jamaica; Born overseas to Jamaican parents or have been naturalized. (2) have resided in Jamaica for a period of at least five (5) years immediately preceding the year of the award. (3) meet the matriculation requirements of the University of the West Indies or the University of Technology

CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- (a) Successful candidate will be bonded to work in Jamaica for a period not exceeding five (5) years.
- (b) The scholarship is valid for the academic year immediately following the offer of the award and cannot be deferred for any reason.

The 2016/2017 Awardee will be a Female.

JAMAICA TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP (OPEN)

- COURSE** : Diploma or First Degree
- TENURE** : Three (3) years
- TENABLE** : At the University of Technology
- VALUE** : Covers tuition fees and book allowance
- ELIGIBILITY** : Candidates should:-
- (a) be sitting at least five (5) subjects in the CXC/GCE O'Level Examination, two of which should be English and Mathematics.
 - (b) be a full-time student of a Technical High School.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

Applicants should apply directly to the University of Technology for admission.

- (a) Successful candidates will be bonded to work in Jamaica for a period not exceeding five (5) years.
- (b) The scholarship is valid for the academic year immediately following the offer of the award and cannot be deferred for any reason.

WHEN TO APPLY: WHEN TO APPLY: March 7 – 31, 2015

JOHN J. MILLS SCHOLARSHIP

- COURSE** : A first Degree
- TENURE** : Three (3) years
- TENABLE** : At the University of the West Indies
- AGE LIMIT** : 35 years of age
- VALUE** : Tuition fee plus maintenance and book allowance
- ELIGIBILITY** : Candidate should:-
- (a) be a graduate of a Teachers' College
 - (b) be a Jamaican National
 - (c) have been accepted at the University of the West Indies

Current scholarship holders are not eligible

KINDLY CONTACT THE PRINCIPAL OF YOUR TEACHERS' COLLEGES AND ASKED THAT YOU TO BE NOMINATED FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP. THE NOMINATION IS BASED ON MERIT.

- COURSE** : Any first Degree
- TENURE** : University of the West Indies
- VALUE** : Tuition fee and book allowance
- ELIGIBILITY** : Candidates should be:
1. Jamaican Nationals
 2. Be not older than 25 years old.
 3. (1) was born in Jamaica or born overseas to parents who are Jamaican citizens **or**
 - ii) have been naturalized as a Jamaican
 - (4) Having met the requirement of **(three) 3** above have resided in Jamaica for a period of at least five years immediately preceding the examination.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- (a) Successful candidates will be bonded to work in Jamaica for a period not exceeding five (5) years
- (b) The scholarship is valid for the academic year immediately following the award and cannot be deferred for any reason.
- (c) Staff dependents and previous holders of this Award are not eligible.

EMANCIPATION SCHOLARSHIP (Undergraduate)
(Open to Male and Female)

- COURSE** : Any First Degree
- TENURE** : Three (3) – Five (5) years
- TENABLE** : University of the West Indies and University of Technology
- VALUE** : Tuition fee, maintenance and book allowance
- AGE LIMIT** : Be under twenty-five (25) years on August 1st of the year of the award
- ELIGIBILITY** : Candidates should:
- (a) have been accepted by or attending the institution or have made his/her own application for admission to the institution
 - (b) (i) was born in Jamaica or born overseas to parents who are Jamaican citizens **or**
 - ii) have been naturalized as a Jamaican
 - (c) Having met the requirement of (b) above have resided in Jamaica for a period of at least five years immediately preceding the examination.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- (a) The successful candidates will be bonded to work in Jamaica for a period not exceeding five (5) years.
- (b) The scholarship is valid for the academic year immediately following the award and cannot be deferred for any reason.

WHEN TO APPLY: March 7 – April 29, 2015

UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP
(Open to Male and Female)

- COURSE** : Any Course offered
- TENURE** : Three (3) – Five (5) years
- TENABLE** : University of Technology
- VALUE** : Tuition fee and book allowance
- AGE LIMIT** : Be no more than thirty (30) years old on October 1st of the year of the award
- ELIGIBILITY** : Candidates should:
- (a) have been accepted or attending the University of Technology or have made their own applications for admission to the University of Technology.

 - (b) **(i)** was born in Jamaica or born overseas to parents who are Jamaican citizens **or**
(ii) have been naturalized as a Jamaican

 - (c) Having met the requirement of (b) above have resided in Jamaica for a period of at least five years immediately preceding the examination.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- (a) The scholarship is valid for the academic year immediately following the award and cannot be deferred for any reason.

- (b) Successful candidates will be bonded to work in Jamaica for a period not exceeding five (5) years.

WHEN TO APPLY: March 7– April 29, 2015

MATHEMATICS/SCIENCE WITH EDUCATION

- TENURE** : Three (3) years
- TENABLE** : At the University of the West Indies or the University of Technology
- VALUE** : Tuition Fee, Maintenance of thirty five thousand (\$35,000.00) and a book allowance of fifteen thousand (\$15,000.00)
- ELIGIBILITY** : Candidates must be graduates of secondary schools, community colleges or have pursued the Double Option Math/Science programme in the teachers' colleges and must **either**:
- (a) have obtained passes in five (5) subject at CXC (General Proficiency or equivalent) including English (A), Mathematics and two (2) approved Science subject; **or** in the CAPE/A level examinations
 - (b) be pursuing a similar programme of study at U.W.I./ U-Tech

CONDITIONS OF THE AWARD:

- (a) All scholarships are tenable at the University of the West Indies, Mona Campus or University of Technology
- (b) All applicants should have been accepted at University of the West Indies, Faculty of Science and Technology (Majoring in Maths or Science with a minor in Education) or the Faculty of Health and Applied Science and Education at the University of Technology
- (c) Successful candidates will be bonded to teach in Government-owned institutions for at least three (3) years.

EMANCIPATION POST-GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

- COURSE** : Candidates may pursue any post-graduate degree programme offered at the University of the West Indies, however preference will be given to the following areas of study:
- (i) Applied Technology in Agriculture
 - (ii) Information Technology
 - (iii) Economics
 - (iv) Environmental Studies
 - (v) Mathematics
- DURATION** : Length of course
- TENABLE** : University of the West Indies, Mona, Cave Hill and St. Augustine
- VALUE** : Three hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000.00) p.a.
- AGE LIMIT** : Be under forty five (45) years old on the first of August in the year of the award
- ELIGIBILITY** : Applicants must:
- (i) have at least an Upper Second Class honours degree, or its equivalent, from a recognised University.
 - (ii) be Jamaican citizens domiciled in Jamaica for at least five (5) years prior to the scholarship.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

- (a) Successful candidates will be bonded to work in Jamaica for a period not less than three years.
- (b) The Scholarship is valid for the academic year immediately following the award and cannot be differed for any reason.

WHEN TO APPLY: NOT BEING OFFERED THIS YEAR

DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

- COURSE** : Diploma in Education Degree
- DURATION OF COURSE** : 1 Year Fulltime
- TENABLE** : At the University of the West Indies
- AGE LIMIT** : 55 years of age
- VALUE** : Tuition fee
- ELIGIBILITY** : Candidate should:-
- (a) be a graduate of a University, holding at least a second class honour degree
 - (b) be a Jamaican National
 - (c) have been accepted at the University of the West Indies

Current scholarship holders are not eligible

CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- (a) Successful candidate will be bonded to work in Jamaica for not less than three (3) years.
- (b) The Scholarship is valid for the academic year immediately following the award and cannot be deferred for any reason.
